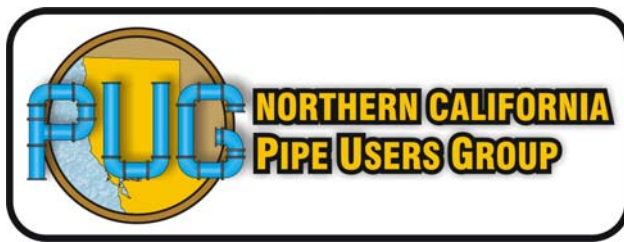

Part 1 of the presentation will provide an overview of the new regulations. The majority of the permit applies equally to linear and traditional construction projects; however there are some important differences for linear projects. The first half of Part 1 will focus on the major new permit elements that apply to both types of projects. The second half of Part 1 will highlight the differences and the unique aspects of linear construction.

Part 2 of the presentation will provide specific guidance on permit compliance. The new State Board database, SMARTS, will be discussed in detail. A sample risk assessment for a linear utility project will then be shown. Next, a BMP overview will be presented, with focus on linear projects. Finally, recommendations on how to prepare for the new requirements will be shared, and questions will be answered.
